In 1958 the City of Henderson and local racing enthusiasts installed a patch of asphalt near what was Dick Stewart Motors on the Boulder Highway near Water Street. That venue became Southern Nevada's first true drag strip "Thunderbird Raceway". Learn about the era of legal drag racing in Henderson.
